

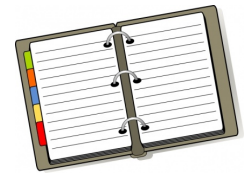

The sun is coming

Keep safe this summer

As we move into the summer term and (hopefully!) begin to enjoy warmer weather, we wanted to share a quick reminder about sun safety in school.

At Woodmansey, we take a sensible and balanced approach to keeping children safe in the sun whilst also encouraging independence.

We ask that:

- Sun cream is applied at home before school on warm, sunny days
- Children may bring a clearly named bottle of sun cream to keep in their bag for reapplication if needed
- Children are encouraged to apply their own sun cream, particularly on arms, face and neck

Staff are not able to routinely apply sun cream to children. If your child requires support with this, please speak to the school office so that we can agree appropriate arrangements through the Administration of Medicines Policy.

In addition, children should:

- Bring a named sun hat to wear at break and lunchtime
- Bring their school water bottle and stay well hydrated throughout the day

We will also ensure that children have access to shade and that outdoor time is managed carefully during periods of hot weather.

Every Moment Matters

Thank you for your support in keeping our attendance high. Our attendance so far this year is 96.1%. Strong attendance is essential in helping children build the knowledge, confidence and routines they need to thrive. Even small amounts of absence can have a significant impact on learning over time.

Every day at Woodmansey is different and varied; we provide as many opportunities as possible to enrich the children's lives and experiences.
